**APPLICANT:** City-initiated

**PROPERTY LOCATION:** City-wide

**REQUEST: Zoning Text Amendment** to modify various provisions of Title 18, Section 18.48.150 of the Colton Municipal Code related to Accessory Dwelling Units (ADUs) and Junior ADUs.

**ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:** Under California Public Resources Code section 21080.17, the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") does not apply to the adoption of an ordinance by a city or county implementing the provisions of section 65852.2 of the Government Code, which is California's ADU law and which also regulates ADUs, as defined by section 65852.22. Therefore, the proposed ordinance is statutorily

exempt from CEQA in that the proposed ordinance implements the State's ADU law.

**STAFF RECOMMENDATION:** Staff recommends that the Planning Commission adopt Resolution titled:
