



POOL RULES

- 1) Guests must abide by all posted rules and regulations.
- 2) NO RUNNING on pool deck or in locker rooms.
- 3) Diving, back jumps, and other dangerous entries into pool are prohibited.
- 4) Horseplay, which can include dunking, breath holding, and piggybacking, are prohibited.
- 5) Individuals wearing coastguard approved PFDs/lifejackets must stay in shallow areas, unless child is accompanied by adult to within 2 feet away.
- 6) Masks covering nose area, snorkels, fins, and mermaid tails are not allowed to be worn in pool.
- 7) Adults must immediately supervise children under 6 years old with active, in-water supervision.
- 8) Injuries occurring within the pool area or locker rooms must be reported to a lifeguard or supervisor immediately.
- 9) For guest protection, use of recording devices (cameras, video cameras and cell phones) is strictly prohibited in locker room areas and restrooms.
- 10) Persons with any open wound, skin infection, diarrhea, or any other communicable disease are not permitted to enter pool.
- 11) Only family-friendly bathing suits and non-cotton streetwear may be worn inside the pool.
- 12) Children 13 years and younger must be accompanied by a parent or adult 18 years or older at a maximum of a 2 children (non-swimmers) per 1 adult ratio.
- 13) All guests are required to pay the admission fee, regardless of intention to use the pool or other attractions. Re-entry is permitted with proof of valid admission.
- 14) Children 17 years and younger who wish to be in the deep end of the pool must pass swimming test (limit one test per day).
- 15) Food, drinks, and chewing gum are not permitted inside the pool. All bags and coolers may be searched prior to entry into the facility. Glass containers are not permitted on the pool deck.
- 16) Infants/children not toilet trained must wear swim diapers (available for purchase at Front Desk).
- 17) Drugs, tobacco, and vaping are prohibited on city property.
- 18) The Colton Aquatics Facility is a family-friendly facility. Inappropriate behavior, language, or attire are not permitted and will be grounds for refusing admission or removal from the facility without a refund.
- 19) The Colton Aquatics Facility is not responsible for lost or stolen items. Guests are encouraged to use on-site lockers to store personal items.
